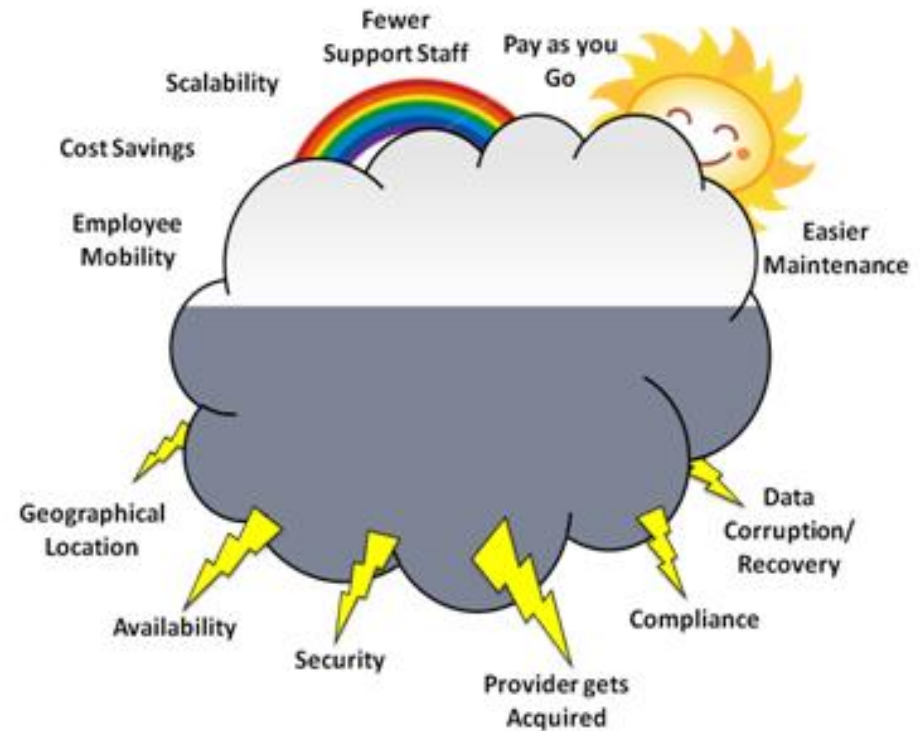
# Cloud computing – from slide ware to mature services

- » **Services starting to mature**
- » **Global trend of larger infrastructure providers teaming up with Telco providers to enable global distribution and fully managed services**
- » **Is a natural next step in the infrastructure roadmap**
  - Utilizing shared services
  - Utilizing ramp-up capabilities
  - Utilizing distributed environments
- » **Needs to be done gradually**
  - Risk
  - Governance
  - Effective cost models



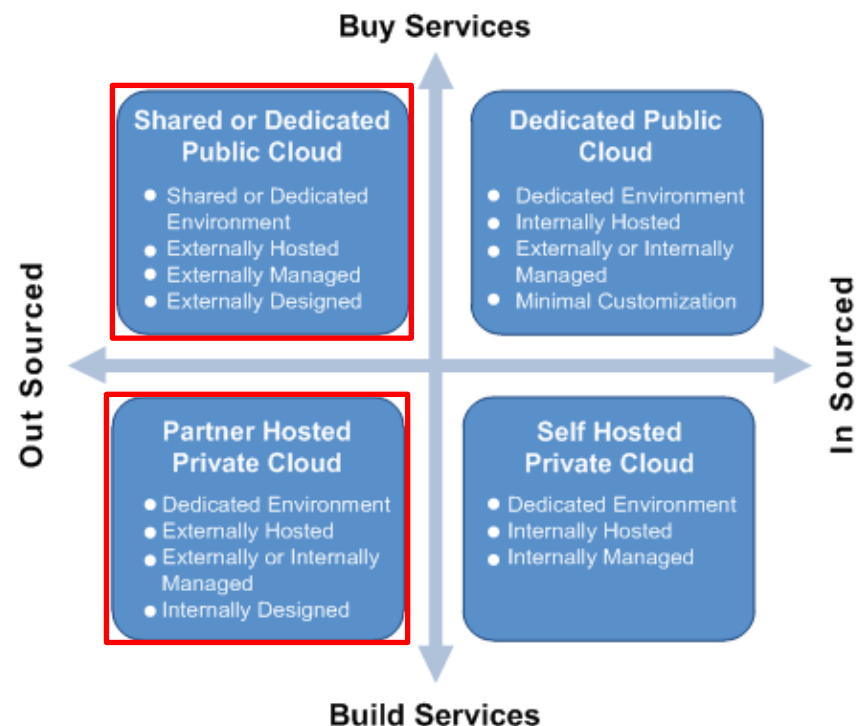
# Cloud success ? ..... tons of areas to consider..

- » An effective governance structure around cloud services is required to meet the business objectives of the organization
- » The extent of infrastructure standardization among the existing applications
- » The complexity and degree of customization and integration of the current architecture
- » The willingness of lines-of-business to share infrastructure
- » Past experience in deploying technologies and concepts critical for clouds, such as consolidation, virtualization and clustering



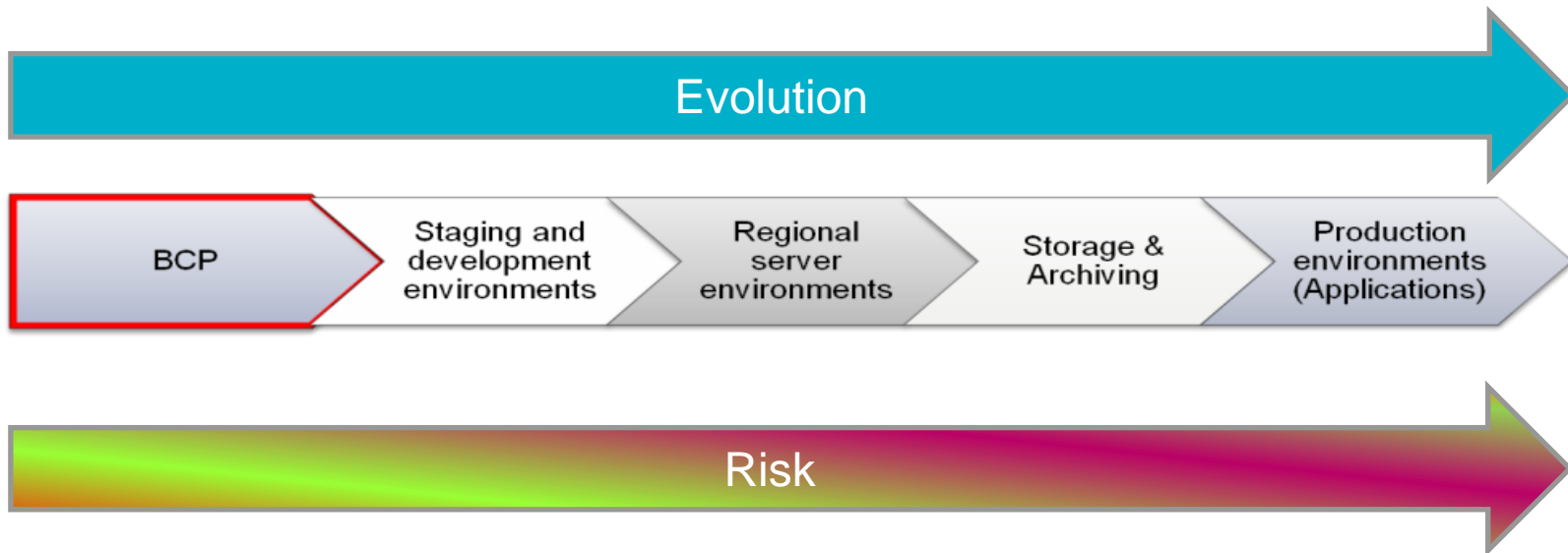
# Public or Private Cloud ? ... difficult to avoid a mix....

- » **We will move toward a Partner Hosted Private Cloud for business critical and bespoke applications**
- » **Will be a mix of**
  - Virtual server resources shared with others
  - Dedicated server resources for bespoke systems
  - Externally hosted
  - Model spans from paying for year on year services...down to paying for the hour....
- » **Other SAAS solutions will run on the public cloud...**



# Our Cloud project describes a staggered roadmap to move WWL's IT infrastructure onto a private cloud solution

- » The path to moving into a shared environment will start with the BCP solution and have clearly defined decision steps pr. phase until production environments is lifted onto the future service
- » The roadmap will last for a significant period of time and we foresee 3-4 years before completion



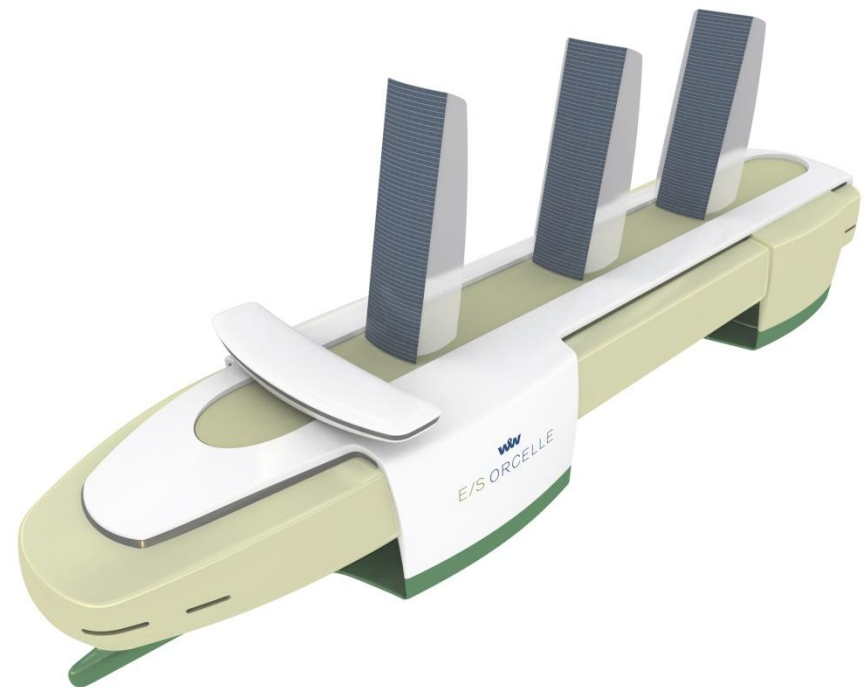
# The "Future end game picture"

- » **Global distribution capabilities**
- » **Closing down the Oslo Data Centre**
- » **Massive capacity in the Private cloud**
  - Dual site production
  - Proximity to global production networks
