

We facilitate the best possible flow of information between operators, partners, authorities and other stakeholders.


Through standardization of work processes and IT soulutions, EPIM helps the industry cut costs and work more effectively.





LogisticsHub history


- Important actors in the industry started to look at opportunities by tracking and use of RFID
- Collaborative work resulting in OLF Guideline 112 on RFID in O&G industry






EPIM LogisticsHub

Architecture from user operator's perspective







- Standardization of master data
